BACKGROUND/PURPOSE

Per Section 19-2-206, C.R.S., there is to be a Juvenile Parole Board ("the Board") consisting of nine (9) members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate. The Governor shall designate one member of the Board to act as Chairperson.

PROCEDURES

CHAIRPERSON:

Upon a vacancy or anticipated vacancy in the position of Chairperson, the Board shall take a majority vote and elect one of the remaining members as a recommendation to the Governor who will fill the position. The Juvenile Parole Board staff shall submit any information required by the Governor's Boards and Commissions office to assist in the Governor's consideration of this recommendation.

VICE-CHAIRPERSON:

The Board, by a majority vote, shall designate one of its members as Vice-Chairperson for a two-year period.

During the January meeting of years ending in an even number, the Board shall take a majority vote to either re-designate the Vice-Chairperson or elect a new member of the Board as Vice-Chairperson.
