1. Regulation Number 9: Open Burning, Prescribed Fire and Permitting

The Bureau of Land Management will request a public hearing for its revised significant user prescribed fire planning document.

2. Regulation Number 11, Parts A and C: Clean Screening

The Division will present to the Commission proposed changes to Regulation Number 11, Parts A and C, permitting government fleet-owned light duty vehicles to be clean screened. The proposed changes also include four housekeeping revisions to clarify and/or delete obsolete provisions to the Regulation.

3. Front Range Ozone Update

The Division, the Regional Air Quality Council, and the North Front Range Transportation and Air Quality Planning Council will pre-review the summertime ozone situation for the Front Range region and describe efforts to reduce ozone precursor emissions that will improve and reduce summertime ozone concentrations. The approach for forecasting high ozone conditions Statewide will also be presented.

The Division will brief the Commission on potential paths forward for the motor vehicle Inspection and Maintenance (I/M) program beyond the year 2014.

6. Oil and Gas Update

(60 minutes presentation, 60 minutes discussion)

The Division will present an overview of oil and gas well development issues, including:

- A short video illustrating the steps on developing a new well
- The latest emission inventories for O&G and any trends, including the control of emissions from natural gas flaring in new oil development areas and short-term emissions from well development
- A review of recent monitoring data and study results, including air toxics sampling concentrations and trends in Garfield County, the Front Range oil and gas areas and urban sites; perspectives on the C.U. School of Public Health Study; and NOAA's methane sampling study
- An overview of EPA's new NSPS OOOO for oil and gas and its impacts on the State
- Review of OGCC's air quality-related regulatory authority/activities and the crossover with the AQCC's rules
