





NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT Rocky Mountain National Park Initiative: 2012 Nitrogen Deposition Milestone Report

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), the National Park Service (NPS), and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) solicit public comment on the Rocky Mountain National Park (RMNP) Initiative 2012 Nitrogen Deposition Milestone Report. This document serves as a progress report, highlighting milestones, policy and management developments, advances in industry best practices, and new research since the release of the 2007 Nitrogen Deposition Reduction Plan.
