

Colorado Food Assistance Program Checklist of Items Needed for Eligibility

Below are some examples of verification that you might need to bring to your interview.

- Proof of Identity:
 - Driver's License
 - ID Card
 - Birth Certificate

- Proof of Residence:
 - Rental Agreement
 - Mortgage Statement
 - Driver's License
 - Rent Receipt
 - Utility Bill (telephone, electric, gas, oil, garbage, water)

- Proof of Immigration Status of Non-Citizens

- Proof of Monthly Income (All applying for food stamps)
 - Paycheck Stubs - for the last 30 days
 - Benefits Letters from SSI or VA
 - Unemployment Insurance Check Stubs
 - Pension Information

- Proof of Out-of-pocket Child Care Expense
 - Cancelled Checks
 - Bill
 - Receipt

- Proof of Monthly Shelter Costs
 - Lease or Mortgage Payment Book
 - Homeowner's Insurance Bills
 - Proof of Property Taxes
 - Proof of all Utilities

- Proof of Monthly Out-of-pocket Medical Expenses for
 - Elderly
 - Disabled

- Social Security Numbers (All applying for food stamps)
