Some positions require possession of a current valid State of Colorado driver's license.	College coursework in a field of study related to the work assignment may substitute year-for-year for the general experience.
ANIMAL CARE II C9A2XX	Two years of experience caring for, feeding, or providing health care for animals in a veterinary laboratory, breeding or boarding facility. One of the two years of the experience must be for research and/or instructional purposes. Some positions require possession of a current valid State of Colorado driver's license.	College coursework in a field of study related to the work assignment may substitute year-for-year for the general experience.
ANIMAL CARE III C9A3XX	Three years of experience caring for, feeding, or providing health care for animals in a veterinary laboratory, breeding or boarding facility. Two years of the three years of experience must be for research and/or instructional purposes. Some positions require possession of a current valid State of Colorado driver's license.	College coursework in a field of study related to the work assignment may substitute year-for-year for the general experience.
