<p>CORRECTIONS CASE MANAGER I</p> <p>A1A1TX</p>	<p>Sixty semester hours of accredited college or university course work with a minimum of thirty semester hours in corrections, criminal justice or behavioral science AND two years corrections-related work experience, one year of which must have included work experience at the level of Correctional/Security Services Officer II.</p> <p>Necessary Special Requirements: Must be at least 21 years of age, have no felony convictions, possess a valid Colorado Driver License.</p>	<p>Corrections-related work experience demonstrating competencies equivalent to those obtained through completion of the required education may be substituted for the education on a year-for-year basis.</p> <p>Corrections-related experience is defined as security (restraining people against their will), custody, counseling, and control of people that involves correcting human behavior.</p>
<p>CORRECTIONS CASE MANAGER II</p> <p>A1A2XX</p>	<p>Sixty semester hours of accredited college or university course work with a minimum of thirty semester hours in corrections, criminal justice or behavioral science AND three years corrections-related work experience, one year of which must have included work experience at the level of Corrections Case Manager I.</p> <p>Necessary Special Requirements: Must be at least 21 years of age, have no felony convictions, possess a valid Colorado Driver License.</p>	<p>Corrections-related work experience demonstrating competencies equivalent to those obtained through completion of the required education may be substituted for the education on a year-for-year basis.</p> <p>Corrections-related experience is defined as security (restraining people against their will), custody, counseling, and control of people that involves correcting human behavior.</p> <p>Note: Positions to be filled in the Central Classifications Unit require one year of work experience as a Corrections Case Manager in Central Classifications.</p>
