Must be at least 21 years of age and have no felony convictions. Some positions may require a valid Colorado Driver License.	Formal education that resulted in demonstrated competencies equivalent to the competencies learned through the required experience may be substituted for the experience.
<b>CORR'L SUPPORT TRADES SUPERVISOR III</b>  <b>A1L3XX</b>	Six years of work experience in the occupational field or specialized area of the work assignment, which included one year of supervisory responsibility at the fully trained, journey level.  Must be at least 21 years of age and have no felony convictions. Some positions may require a valid Colorado Driver License.	Formal education that resulted in demonstrated competencies equivalent to the competencies learned through the required experience may be substituted for the experience.
<b>CORR'L SUPPORT TRADES SUPERVISOR IV</b>  <b>A1L4XX</b>	Seven years of work experience in the occupational field or specialized area of the work assignment, which included one year of experience at the level of Correctional Support Supervisor III.  Must be at least 21 years of age and have no felony convictions. Some positions may require a valid Colorado Driver License.	Formal education that resulted in demonstrated competencies equivalent to the competencies learned through the required experience may be substituted for the experience.
