<b>TAX COMPLIANCE AGENT I</b>  <b>B3J2TX</b>	One year of experience in the collection of state revenues by contacting and assisting delinquent taxpayers and their representatives.	Work experience which provided the same kind, amount, and level of knowledge acquired in the required education may be substituted on a year-for-year basis for the bachelor's degree.
<b>TAX COMPLIANCE AGENT II</b>  <b>B3J3XX</b>	Four years of experience in tax compliance work including at least three years of full operating level experience.	Work experience which provided the same kind, amount, and level of knowledge acquired in the required education may be substituted on a year-for-year basis for the bachelor's degree.
<b>TAX COMPLIANCE AGENT III</b>  <b>B3J4XX</b>	Two years of experience supervising Tax Compliance Agents responsible for contacting and assisting delinquent taxpayers to ensure the collection of state revenues.
