Agreement to complete additional educational and work requirements within 5 years of becoming a certified state employee.	Bachelor's Degree in Human Services related field plus 2 years of professional experience working directly with individuals who have disabilities.
Rehabilitation Counselor I H6R2TX	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's degree in Rehabilitation Counseling OR possession of a current Certified Rehabilitation Counselor Certification (CRCC) OR be eligible to apply for the CRC credential.	
Rehabilitation Counselor II H6R2TX	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's degree in Rehabilitation Counseling OR possession of a current Certified Rehabilitation Counselor credential that was issued by the Commission for Rehabilitation Counselor Certification (CRCC) OR be eligible to apply for the CRC credential AND TWO YEARS of professional experience appropriate to the work assignment beyond the eligibility requirement to apply for the CRC credential.	
Rehabilitation Supervisor I H6R4XX	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's Degree in Rehabilitation Counseling OR possession of a current Certified Rehabilitation Counselor (CRC) credential that was issued by the Commission for Rehabilitation Counselor Certification (CRCC) OR be eligible to apply for the CRC credential AND four years of professional experience related to the work assignment.	
Rehabilitation Supervisor II H6R5XX	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's Degree in Rehabilitation Counseling OR possession of a current Certified Rehabilitation Counselor (CRC) credential that was issued by the Commission for Rehabilitation Counselor Certification (CRCC) OR be eligible to apply for the CRC credential AND five years of professional experience related to the work assignment. One year of the experience must have been managing and supervising the day-to-day operations of a single rehabilitation program, including budget and policy planning, development and implementation.
