Must possess Colorado Type VI Authorization-Temporary, Colorado Provisional or Professional Teacher License.	In agencies with documented recruitment difficulties the Alternative Teaching License may substitute for a Colorado Provisional or Professional Teacher License.
TEACHER I (ACADEMIC) J1A1*D	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a master's degree in a field of study related to the work assignment. Must possess Colorado Type VI Authorization-Temporary, Colorado Provisional or Professional Teacher License.	In agencies with documented recruitment difficulties the Alternative Teaching License may substitute for a Colorado Provisional or Professional Teacher License.
TEACHER I (ACADEMIC) J1A1*E	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a master's degree in a field of study related to the work assignment plus 20 graduate semester credit hours of beyond the master's degree in course work related to the program goals and objectives. Must possess Colorado Type VI Authorization-Temporary, Colorado Provisional or Professional Teacher License.	In agencies with documented recruitment difficulties the Alternative Teaching License may substitute for a Colorado Provisional or Professional Teacher License.
TEACHER I (ACADEMIC) J1A1*F	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a doctorate degree (Ph.D. or Ed.D.) in a field of study related to the work assignment. Must possess Colorado Type VI Authorization-Temporary, Colorado Provisional or Professional Teacher License.	In agencies with documented recruitment difficulties the Alternative Teaching License may substitute for a Colorado Provisional or Professional Teacher License.
TEACHER II (ACADEMIC) J1A2*A	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a master's degree in a field of study related to the work assignment and three years of professional education experience. Must possess and maintain Colorado Provisional Teacher, Provisional Principal or Professional Teacher or Professional Principal License.	
TEACHER III (ACADEMIC) J1A3*A	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a master's degree in a field of study related to the work assignment and five years of professional education experience. Two years of the five years experience may be required experience at a principal, administrator, or superintendent level. Must possess and maintain Colorado Provisional Teacher, Provisional Principal License or Professional Teacher or Professional Principal License or a Professional Administrator License.	

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TEACHER I (VOCATIONAL) J1A1*H	Education and experience requirements are those required for the specific occupation by the Community Colleges of Colorado (CC of C) for the vocational credential. Must possess an Emergency, three-year, or a five-year credential issued by the State of Colorado with the endorsement appropriate to the assignment.	
TEACHER I (VOCATIONAL) J1A1*I	In addition to the education and experience required for the next lower level (J1A1*H), achievement of 20 semester hours of college credits related to the assignment. Must possess and maintain a valid five-year vocational credential issued by the State of Colorado.	
TEACHER I (VOCATIONAL) J1A1*J	In addition to the education and experience required for the next lower level (J1A1*I), achievement of 40 semester hours of college credits related to the assignment. Must possess and maintain a valid five-year vocational credential issued by the State of Colorado.	
TEACHER I (VOCATIONAL) J1A1*K	In addition to the education and experience required for the next lower level (J1A1*J), graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in vocational education or a closely related field. Must possess and maintain a valid five-year vocational credential issued by the State of Colorado.	
TEACHER I (VOCATIONAL) J1A1*L	In addition to the education and experience required for the next lower level (J1A1*K), graduation from an accredited college or university with a master's degree in vocational education or a closely related field. Must possess and maintain a valid five-year vocational credential issued by the State of Colorado.	
TEACHER II (VOCATIONAL) J1A2*G	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in vocational education or a closely related field and three years of professional vocational education teaching experience appropriate to the assignment. Must possess and maintain a valid five-year vocational credential issued by the State of Colorado.	
TEACHER III (VOCATIONAL) J12A3*G	Graduation from college with a master's degree in vocational education, or closely related field and five years of professional vocational education teaching and/or administrative experience. Must possess and maintain a valid five-year vocational credential issued by the State of Colorado.
