Pursuant to remand, the Board enters an order, affirming its August 20, 1999 Order in which attorney fees for defending the appeal were awarded to Complainant, as stated in the Court of Appeals' Order Affirmed and Cause Remanded with Directions, Case No. 99CA1929, which was issued January 11, 2001. The case will now be assigned to an administrative law judge and set for hearing to determine the amount that Mount View must reimburse Complainant for reasonable attorney fees and costs incurred in defending the appeal, pursuant to the order of the Court of Appeals.
