At this public meeting, the Board reviewed the Preliminary Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned case. The Board voted to reject the Preliminary Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge and grant the petition for hearing, noting that the military leave policy from facility to facility is inconsistent and such a policy may discourage employees from taking military training.
