This matter is before the Colorado State Personnel Board ("Board") at its regularly scheduled public session held on February 19, 2008. During this public session, the Board considered the Mandate from the Court of Appeals, Court of Appeals No. 06CA1377, Order Reversed and Case Remanded with Directions, received January 8, 2008, by the Board.

Based upon the Board's review and consideration,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Initial Decision of the Administrative Law Judge, with regard to the November 2004 disciplinary action, is reversed. Respondent is ordered to rescind the November 2004 disciplinary action in its entirety, and the matter is remanded to the Administrative Law Judge for a determination of attorney fees awarded to Complainant, in compliance with the Court of Appeals' order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Board staff shall set a briefing schedule on the issue of the award of attorney fees to Complainant, to be determined by the Administrative Law Judge.


