IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Request for a Residency Waiver for the positions of Nursing Home Administrator (General Professional VII) and Director of Admissions (General Professional III) be **DENIED**. However, the Board grants the Department of Human Services leave to file for reconsideration of its Request for Residency Waiver if it would supplement its request with additional information, including market data, which demonstrates a systemic problem in filling these positions.
