

# Colorado Motorist Insurance Information Database (MIIDB) Transition Project Status Update February 28, 2007

## Test Policy File Processing

The volume of testing continues to be significant. We are trying to get everyone into Production as soon as possible. The Division of Insurance has asked for a status of all insurance companies as of the end of March.

## Production Policy File Processing

Production policy files received in Colorado.gov's Information Exchange Production Mailbox or in Colorado.gov's Production FTP INBOX folders are being processed on a daily basis. Immediately after processing policy files, Acknowledgment files (if requested) and Error files (if errors) are returned to the Trading Partner.

## DriveInsured Website

The Trading Partner Account Management area of the DriveInsured website is now available. You must have properly submitted the Registration Agreement and received your User Ids and Passwords in order to enter this area of the website. Instructions for using the Account Management area are included on the DriveInsured website.
