Criteria for Consideration

1) Strength of Project Plan

- 4 Strong written policies, elected official buy-in, feedback reporting, measurement and electronic controls in place and provided at time of application
- 2 Partial practices, policies and mandates in place and provided at time of application
- 1 Minimal planning or buy-in in place/provided at time of application
- 0 No planning

2) Expected Usage/ year per Site (incremental)

- 4 greater than 30,001 gallons
- 2 20,001- 30,000 gallons
- 1 10,001-20,000 gallons
- 0 less than 10,000 gallons

3) FFV Fleet and GBC Goal Attainment

- 4 FFV fleet 20+ or meets goals of GBC strategic plan for CO-Ops (and emergency services?) and no other municipal or county fleet funded within 5 miles
- 2 FFV fleet 15 - 20, does not meet goals of GBC strategic plan for CO-Ops
- 1 Small FFV fleet 5 - 10, does not meet goals of GBC or other municipal or county fleet funded within 5 miles
- 0 FFV fleet under 5, does not meet GBC strategic plan for CO-Ops other municipal or county fleet funded within 5 miles

4) MOU Points

- 3 Multiple MOUs or IGAs signed
- 2 Single MOU or IGA signed
- 1 MOU or IGA planned but not finalized, draft included with applicator
- 0 No MOU or IGA planned
