Completeness Determination, Radioactive Materials License Application And Environmental Report, Piñon Ridge Mill Project


Dear Mr. Antony,

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment Radiation Control Program has reviewed the radioactive materials license application and related materials submitted on November 18, 2009 for the proposed Piñon Ridge Mill Facility in Montrose County. We find the application package to be substantially complete, and will initiate an adequacy determination as described in the Radiation Control Act and the Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Radiation Control.

Part of our adequacy review will require that additional information be provided to us, including a more detailed settlement analysis, representative geotechnical data for proposed borrow materials to be used for caps and erosion protection, and a decision criteria matrix for selecting foundation designs. We expect to contact you shortly regarding a meeting with your technical staff to explain our initial request in more detail.

You are reminded that part of the requirements for this review process include two public meetings and the provision of financial support to the Montrose County Commissioners for independent review of the application and environmental report. We understand that you have proposed the first public meeting to be held at the Nucla High School on Thursday, January 21, 2010 at 6 PM, and the second at the Montrose Pavilion on Wednesday, February 17, 2010, time to be determined.

We look forward to continuing our review of your submittals, and will contact you shortly to arrange our first review meeting. Should you have any questions, please contact me at 303-692-3423.
