Notice of Public Meetings Regarding the Piñon Ridge Mill and Opportunity for Public Comment

Energy Fuels Resources Corporation submitted a Radioactive Materials License Application for the proposed Piñon Ridge Mill, located about 12 miles west of Naturita in Paradox Valley, to the Radiation Program of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) on November 18, 2009. The mill is designed to process uranium and vanadium ores mined in the area. Two public meetings have been scheduled to allow members of the public to provide comments on the license application to the CDPHE. The meeting dates, location and times are as follows.
