Piñon Ridge Mill License Application, Montrose County, Colorado

Dear Steve:

Energy Fuels requests a time extension for responding to Request for Information No. 3 (RFI #3) dated August 19, 2010. RFI #3 is quite large and detailed with over 400 separate informational requests. We have made good progress in addressing many of the questions raised; however, we do not want to send our responses back in a piecemeal fashion. Accordingly, we request the following extensions beyond the 45-day delivery schedule so that we can completely address each topic in a comprehensive manner.

1. An additional 15 days to respond to Attachments 1, Parts 1 and 2 of Attachment 3 (i.e., Facility Operating Plan and MILDOS AREA modeling), and Part 1 of Attachment 4 (i.e., Health and Safety Plan). This submittal would occur on or about October 18, 2010.
2. An additional 30 days to respond to Attachment 2 and Part 2 of Attachment 4 (i.e., Emergency Response Plan). In addition to construction quality control plans, the Attachment 2 Response will also include updated construction and closure specifications. This submittal would occur on or about November 3, 2010. We also anticipate that responses to RFI #4 will be submitted during this same time period.
3. An additional 45 days to respond to Parts 3 and 4 of Attachment 3 (Exposure Pathways and Risk Assessment reports). Revision of these reports has been contracted to SENES Consultants Limited. This submittal would occur on or about November 18, 2010. We also anticipate submitting an off-site Habitat Improvement Plan during this same time period for review by the Radiation Management Program and the Colorado Division of Wildlife.
