### EXECUTIVE ORDER

#### Continuing the Community Corrections Advisory Council

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Office of the Governor of the State of Colorado, I John W. Hickenlooper, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order continuing the Community Corrections Advisory Council (the "Council").

#### I. Background and Need

The purpose of the Community Corrections Program is to develop local correctional programs and facilities. Pursuant to C.R.S. § 17-27-108, the Division of Criminal Justice within the Colorado Department of Public Safety, is statutorily authorized to administer and execute all contracts for the provision of community corrections facilities and programs. In order to ensure that the program is effective, continued and close coordination among local government, state criminal justice agencies, private-sector organizations and the General Assembly is necessary. The purpose of the Council is to provide that coordination.

#### II. Membership and Organization

The Council shall consist of not more than 25 members serving no more than two consecutive four year terms. Members must be knowledgeable of the problems and responsibilities of community corrections in Colorado. Council members shall receive no compensation for their services. The Governor shall designate one of the Council members to serve as Chair of the Council.

#### III. Duties

The Council shall have the following duties:

- A. Analyze and identify problems and needs of the community corrections system;
- B. Recommend modification to the *Colorado Community Corrections Standards* and community corrections contracts to improve the quality of programs and to enhance public safety;
- C. Identify and recommend evidence-based strategies to increase success rates and to reduce recidivism in community corrections;

- D. Evaluate and recommend strategies to maximize use of funding and to promote efficient and effective allocation methods to local jurisdictions;
- E. Address issues identified by the Governor and the Colorado General Assembly in the areas of community corrections system.
- F. Provide coordinated communication to providers, boards, referral agencies, and the general public in order to facilitate the advancement of community corrections in the State of Colorado

IV. Directive

The Community Corrections Advisory Council is hereby continued, without interruption. This Executive Order shall repeal and supersede all previous Executive Orders pertaining to the Community Corrections Advisory Council, specifically Executive Orders B 036 89, B 030 91, B 016 94, B 004 04, and B 015 08.

V. Duration

This Executive Order shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded by a future Executive Order of the Governor.
