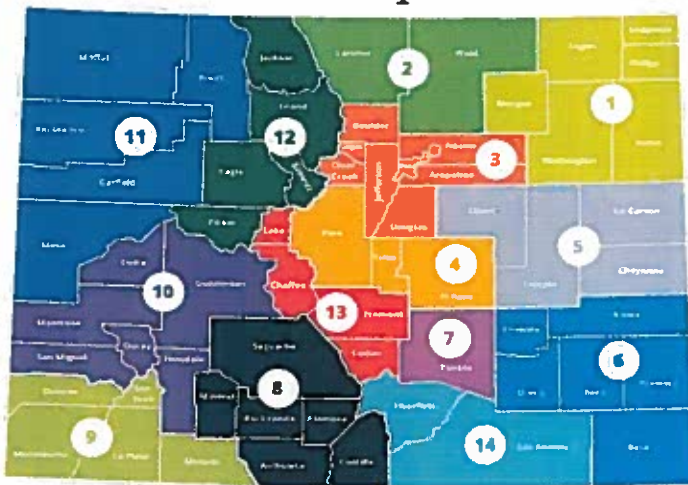


Colorado Sector Partnerships

2016 Sector Grant Overview

Colorado Workforce Development Council offered grants to active or emerging regional sector partnerships that have demonstrated the use of Colorado's sector partnership model. Over \$500,000 was awarded to 13 sector partnership across the state. Each of the partnerships were eligible to receive \$30,681 to support the growth of their priorities that focus on solutions to keep business strong, create better opportunities for job seekers, and align education to meet the high workforce demand.
