2 **ESF # 2: Credentialing Personnel Credentialing**

3 The Colorado Credentialing Working Group has developed minimum training standards for
4 several positions and has grouped them using the Emergency Support Function framework so
5 that it is easier to locate a specific credential.

6 To participate in the Colorado Identification and Credentialing Program, communications
7 personnel (ESF #2) must possess and provide proof of a valid Colorado driver’s license with
8 appropriate FCC and amateur radio licensing as appropriate.

9 In accordance with NIMS standards, all personnel are also required to complete the following
10 base training courses (in addition to any other required coursework specified for respective
11 positions): IS 100, 200, 700, and 800. Personnel must have a current, valid driver’s license or
12 State-issued ID card.
