

Colorado RENU Loan Contractor Application Checklist

Please refer to the following checklist to become an Authorized Contractor in the Colorado Energy Office (CEO) Residential Energy Upgrade (RENU) Loan Contractor Network.

Required documents

- Completed contractor application and signed participation agreement (5 pages total)
- Proof of commercial liability insurance (CEO must be listed as additional insured)
- Proof of workers' compensation insurance
- State or local professional license (electrician, plumbing, mechanical, etc.)
- Relevant certifications
 - Air sealing / insulation = BPI Building Analyst, Envelope Professional, Air Leakage Control Installer, Quality Control Inspector, or Energy Auditor.
 - PV = NABCEP PV Installation Professional or PV Technical Sales
 - Energy assessment / audit = RESNET or BPI Building Analyst, Energy Auditor, or Quality Control Inspector

Business requirements

- Good standing with the Colorado Secretary of State
- A listing in the Better Business Bureau (business does not need to be accredited)

- Attend RENU contractor training
