

Embedding Facebook Feeds

Entities must be able to implement and maintain the content they add to their sites; Colorado Interactive will not be able to assist with embedding Facebook feeds beyond providing the guidance in this document. The embed code generated by Facebook does not work in Pacific; use the following template for your embed code instead:

Enter your entity's Facebook page name in each bracketed section. Located the page name in your entity's Facebook page's URL.



A completed Facebook embed code will look similar to the example below:

Be sure to click the "Source" button in the WYSIWYG prior to pasting the code.

NOTE: We recommend double checking that your Facebook feed displays correctly while logged out of Facebook. This will allow you to double check that your Facebook page's permission settings are correct. The iframe will not display correctly for all users if your Facebook page's permissions are stricter.
