Rules

- A. All projects listed under this department will be judged on the Danish system. All exhibits will be placed in a blue, red or white group and receive ribbons accordingly. In addition a Champion and Reserve Champion will be chosen in the metal and wood divisions with a grand and reserve grand champion Ag Mechanics being awarded.
- B. An entry consists of one or more items entered by an individual or group in a single class to be judged together. Example: Multiple panels or gates may make up one entry.
- C. Entries are open to 4-H & FFA youth of Kit Carson County only.
- D. Entry must be primarily constructed by the individual or group entering the exhibit.
- E. Entries must have been completed within one year of entry date.
- F. Entry will include constructed project, project plans and cost of materials.
- G. Judging will be based on the following: a) Evidence of sound planning; b) Number and degree of skills involved; c) Practicality of entry; d) Quality of Workmanship.
- H. Classes may be divided into large and small upon the discretion of the judge.
