### Colorado Quilting Council Award

A \$25 cash award and ribbon will be awarded to a first time quilt exhibitor. This award will be chosen by the quilt judge. The cash prize will be mailed within 30 days of the event. First time entries must be identified on the entry tag.

#### Rules

- A. This department will be judged on the Danish system. All exhibits will receive a blue, red, or white ribbon.
- B. All work must be exhibitor's own work and not previously exhibited at the Kit Carson County Fair.
- C. Quilts must have been completed within the past 5 years.
- D. Only one item per class per person is eligible.
- E. Exhibitors are responsible for completing entry tags prior to entering their exhibits.
- F. Articles on exhibit must be clean, free of odors and pet hair.
- G. Cover name labels attached to quilts.
- H. A professional will be defined as one who receives income as an instructor or has designed and sold patterns and/or has done custom quilting either hand or machine for others.
- I. Person entering item is responsible for removing it from exhibition building.
- J. Fair management will not be responsible for articles left after release time.

#### Best of Show Judging Criteria

- A. Quality; Beauty; Originality
- B. Best of show exhibits will be predominately displayed and will receive a \$25 cash award unless otherwise specified by sponsor. If no exhibit merits the honor, the award will not be given.

Eligible classes (1-107) **Open Class Quilt Best of Show** is being sponsored by Lazy K Coach.

Definition of a quilt:

- 1. Three layers – top, batting, backing.
- 2. Held together by quilting stitches through all three layers.

Quilt Classifications:

- A. Large Quilts – Full, Queen or King.
- B. Small Quilts – Twin, juvenile or throw.
- C. Baby Quilts.
- D. Hand Quilted – quilts that are 100% hand quilted.
- E. Machine Quilted – Quilts that are 100% machine quilted.
- F. Mostly Pieced – At least 75% of the surface of the quilt top is pieced by hand or machine.
- G. Mostly Appliqued – At least 75% of the surface of the quilt top consists of appliquéd motifs applied by either hand or machine.
- H. Mixed/Other Surface Techniques – Any quilt that consists of a fairly equal combination of piecing and appliqué or those that consists of one or more other surface techniques such as hand embroidery, machine embroidery, fabric paint, embellishments, photo transfers, whole cloth, etc.
- I. Hand Pieced – At least 75% of the surface of the quilt top is pieced by hand.
- J. Machine Pieced – At least 75% of the surface of the quilt top is pieced by machine.
- K. Hand Embroidered – At least 75% of the surface of the quilt top is embroidered by hand.
- L. Machine Embroidered – At least 75% of the surface of the quilt top is embroidered by machine.
- M. Miniature Quilts – Quilts that are miniature representations of full size quilts. Maximum perimeter must be 96" or less. All surface techniques, quilting and finishing should be miniature in scale.
- N. Novelty Quilts – Bed covers that do not have any quilting stitches or traditional top techniques such as piecing and appliqué. Biscuit quilts, Cathedral Window, Crazy Quilts (if not quilted), and Yo-Yo's would fall in this category.
- O. Group Quilts – Combined efforts of two or more persons on a quilt top. At least one person must still be living.
- P. Junior Quilts – If 75% or more of a quilt is made by a junior (age 11 & under) or (age 12-18) in collaboration with an adult, it may be entered in the Junior Quilts Division.
- Q. Art Quilt – Original design only!
