NOTES | ACTIONS

- Development of the Watershed Restoration Planning (WRP) Programmatic Environmental Assessment (PEA) is underway. The draft of this document will be submitted to the DURT team for technical review before being made available for public comment.
- Investigate the relevancy of combining the efforts of the Transportation Risk and Resiliency Model (report completed), with FEMA and Governor's Long Term Recovery office risk analysis initiatives.
- CWCB has adopted Best Available Floodplain Data (signed resolutions coming in a month).
- CWCB analysis completed up to the Front Range and available on CDOT website, phase two underway looking out to Platte River.
- Central Federal Lands have corridor plans swapping river and roadway, help on watershed PEA
- Leveraging S.B. 40 for compliance. What would this look like?
- Applications for funding are due to DOLA by mid-march for the first round of watershed projects (projects < \$300K).
- Opportunities identified to incorporate resource awareness into the F-MAG program. Resource advisors are local and could provide a summary of data and expertise available.
