Tools

- Solicit NGOs for DURT participation opportunities
- Expand all relevant programmatic agreements to include other agencies. Share existing documents.
- Clearly define *emergency* action definitions between agencies.
- EHP gained 4 local hires to work on compliance reviews and research.
- GIS: FEMA will move towards the creation of a DURT members restricted GeoPlatform. This platform will serve as an interagency tool for the sharing of and general awareness of individual agency actions and data.

Floodplain \ Implementation of Executive Orders (EO) 11988 & 11990

- Seek clear definition of legal responsibility
- Water conservation held meeting to figure out needs and requests from locals. Waiting on funding and final processing of LiDAR.
- Goals: Each community should have their own map and give estimates so they have something to work with.
 - CWCB will contribute a matrix detailing the degree of individual community involvement and best available datas.
- Jamestown hired AMEC for construction. Check the streams for critical habitat.

Endangered Species Act / National Historic Preservation Act

- We should assume the preamble jumping mouse moved with the stream.
- FEMA is funding all head gates. Looking to make head gates fish friendly and cost efficient.

Conclusion

- DURT continues to make inroads between agencies that previously may not have been as communicative. Transparency continues to increase around unique processes surrounding uniform compliance needs. These new connections are a major result of the DURT effort.
