**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENT BETWEEN MORGAN COUNTY AND ENABLE PROPERTIES, LLC AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENT AND RELATED CLOSING DOCUMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, Enable Properties, LLC is the owner of real property located in Morgan County, Colorado, as identified in the Purchase and Sale Agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit A** (the "Purchase and Sale Agreement"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Morgan County Board of County Commissioners wishes to purchase the property which is the subject of the Purchase and Sale Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Morgan County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado hereby approves the Purchase and Sale Agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and authorizes the Chairman to execute the same.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby further authorizes the Chairman to execute all documents required to effectuate the purchase of the property which is the subject of the Purchase and Sale Agreement with no further approval or action of the Board of Commissioners required.

Chairman Zwetzig presented to the Board Resolution 2019 BCC 16, a Resolution Approving a Purchase between Morgan County and Enable Properties, LLC and Authorizing the Chairman to Execute the Purchase and Sale Agreement and Related Closing Documents. Chairman Zwetzig explained that during the judicial center and jail assessment performed by the LR Group, it was determined the existing structure had some value and it should be considered the most economical value in planning for growth and the needs of that building and consequently they advised the county to purchase any adjoining property and two lots have become available, and it was discussed with the owners of Enable Properties and they have agreed to sell the two lots as outlined in the purchase and sale agreement. Chairman Zwetzig read aloud the legal description and indicated where these two lots are located. Chairman Zwetzig stated the amount of the purchase is \$300,000.00.

Commissioner Arndt made the motion to approve Resolution 2019 BCC 16 a Resolution Approving a Purchase between Morgan County and Enable Properties, LLC and Authorizing the Chairman to Execute the Purchase and Sale Agreement and Related Closing Documents in the amount of \$300,000.00 for the future needs of the Morgan County Justice Center. Commissioner Becker seconded the motion. Commissioner Becker asked that it be noted that as a result of this purchase, the Commissioners have since placed another piece of property on the market whereas there is a current bid process in place which are due by July 31, 2019. Discussion followed with the explanation that Morgan County owns property located at County Road 24, Dodd Bridge Road, which in the past has been leased to the Colorado Division of Wildlife who no longer wishes to lease it and it has been placed on the market and bids are being accepted in hopes the revenue from the sale of this land will cover the costs of this purchase. At this time, the motion carried 3-0.

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING A USE BY SPECIAL REVIEW FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF A LIVESTOCK CONFINEMENT FACILITY LOCATED IN THE W1/2 OF SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 60 WEST OF THE 6<sup>TH</sup> P.M., MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO**

**WHEREAS**, Magnum Feedyard, LLC (the “Applicant”) has applied to amend an existing special use permit it was issued in 1998 via Resolution 1998 BCC 16 for a livestock confinement facility (the “Application”) located in the E½ of Section 6, Township 2 North, Range 60 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Morgan County, and addressed as 11665 County Road 1, Wiggins, Colorado (the “Property”);

**WHEREAS**, on June 10, 2019, after holding a duly noticed public hearing, the Morgan County Planning Commission recommended that the Application be approved with certain conditions;

**WHEREAS**, on July 9, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners of Morgan County, Colorado held a public hearing on the Application;

**WHEREAS**, notice of the public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was properly published and the notice was properly posted at the Property;

**WHEREAS**, during the public hearing the Board of County Commissioners received testimony and evidence from staff, the Applicant and the public; and

**WHEREAS**, after considering all relevant testimony and evidence, the Board of County Commissioners desires to approve the Application, subject to certain conditions set forth herein.

**NOW, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO:**

## **1. APPROVAL.**

The Application is hereby granted, subject to the conditions set forth herein. This Resolution shall constitute the special use permit (hereinafter referred to as this "Resolution" or the "Permit").

## **2. FINDING OF FACT.**

Subject to the Applicant meeting and complying with all conditions set forth herein, the following findings are made:

- a. The use and location are in conformance with the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan. Specifically:
  - i. The project will broaden the employment opportunities for residents and will further economic growth.
  - ii. The proposed use is compatible with existing land uses and there is access to established public infrastructure.
  - iii. The use will protect existing agriculture operations by allowing them to continue while not restricting private property rights.

In particular, the Property is located in the southwest planning area as defined by the Morgan County Comprehensive Plan. Areas north and south of the Wiggins are home to several feeding operations. In this area Comprehensive Plan goals include encouraging the preservation of agricultural production land to ensure continuation of this important industry. The Application will encourage the preservation and the continuation of the industry.

- b. The application is complete and presents a clear picture of how the use is to be arranged on the site.
- c. The site conforms to the district design standards of Sections 4-109 through 4-260 of the Morgan County Zoning Regulations.
- d. All on and off-site impacts have been satisfactorily mitigated either through agreement, public improvements, site plan requirements or other mitigation measures. Impacts to surrounding properties have been mitigated and documented in the Preliminary Environmental System Design and the Management Plan for Nuisance Control Plan that was approved as part of the 1998 application.
- e. The special use is compatible with surrounding uses and is adequately buffered from any incompatible uses by distance and topography.
- f. This special use poses only the minimum amount of risk to the public health, safety and welfare.
- g. The special use will not be located on a nonconforming parcel of land.
- h. The Applicant has adequately documented a public need for the project in the form of increased economic development. The Applicant has submitted all pertinent technical information, has demonstrated that it has adequate financial resources to implement the project, and has paid all County fees and review costs.
- i. The applicant has demonstrated a source of water which is adequate for the proposed use in terms of quantity and reliability.

## **3. CONDITIONS.**

The approval of the use by special review is conditioned upon the following:

- a. Total animal units are limited to 35,000.
- b. Owner shall remove Owner's sign on County Road 3 directing traffic to the Property via County Road M.
- c. Owner shall provide haulers serving the Property with a preferred route as approved by the County on a biannual basis.
- d. If the speed limit on County Road M is modified by the County and County erects new speed limit signs, Owner shall reimburse the County for the costs of the new signs and their installation up to a maximum amount of \$500.
- e. This Resolution supersedes and replaces Resolution 98 BCC 16.

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## 4. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

- a. The Board of County Commissioners retains continuing jurisdiction over this Permit to ensure compliance with this Permit and the Morgan County Zoning Regulations. County Representatives are authorized to inspect the Property at any reasonable time upon notice to the Applicant.
- b. The Applicant shall comply with all governmental and regulatory agency requirements and permits, including without limitation those promulgated for the protection of health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of Morgan County. Such compliance shall include without limitation compliance with the regulations of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, the Colorado Department of Agriculture, and the United States Environmental Protection Agency.
- c. This approval is conditioned on compliance with all information and representations contained in the Application and presented by the Applicant, which are incorporated into this Resolution.
- d. This Applicant shall comply with all requirements, conditions and design standards set forth herein. Noncompliance shall be grounds for revocation of this permit by the Morgan County Board of Commissioners after notice and hearing.

Morgan County Planning and Zoning Planning Director/Floodplain Administrator, Pam Cherry presented a Resolution Granting a Use by Special Review for Establishment of a Livestock Confinement Facility Located in the W1/2 Of Section 5, Township 2 North, Range 60 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Morgan County, Colorado. Ms. Cherry explained this was an application for an amendment to a Special Use issued to Magnum Feedyard Co, LLC. The request is to expand the footprint to include additional acreage on the east side of Morgan County Road 1.

Ms. Cherry stated that on July 9, 2019 this application was considered by the Board of County Commissioners and was approved with conditions on a vote of 3-0. Ms. Cherry explained that this is the resolution that has been prepared to reflect the outcome of the hearing.

Discussion ensued regarding the speed limit issue with Commissioner Arndt reflecting the information in the resolution that outlines the speed limit matter. He further made note they want to be sure they are complying with all the legal requirements regarding the speed limit matter. Commissioner Becker also made mention about what power the Board actually has in changing the speed limit and will be reviewing what needs to be done over the next couple of weeks.

Commissioner Becker made a motion to approve Resolution 2019 BCC 17, a Resolution Granting A Use By Special Review For Establishment Of A Livestock Confinement Facility Located In The W1/2 Of Section 5, Township 2 North, Range 60 West Of The 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Morgan County, Colorado as presented and noting the conditions as well that are included in the resolution with Commissioner Arndt seconding the motion. Commissioner Arndt noted this does not expand the number of animal units, as they remain the same as what was approved in 1998; it only expands the actual footprint. At this time, the motion carried 3-0.

### **Consideration of Approval – Economic Development Incentive Policy For Morgan County**

Commissioner Becker presented to the Board the Economic Development Incentive Policy for Morgan County. Commissioner Becker explained that Morgan County could be argued whether or not there is an incentive policy and stated an incentive policy is to bring new businesses and industry into the County. He believes there will be arguments on both sides of this whether it works economically or not. He states Morgan County is a county with no sales tax and the need for businesses to experience necessary growth and incentives are a tool that would benefit this growth. He spoke about the past incentives that have been offered and how those may not have provided a benefit after a period of time. He explained in detail the incentive policy that is being proposed explaining the targeted industries, and the eligibility criteria proposed. Incentive agreements were also reviewed as well as the administration of the incentive process.

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Commissioner Becker stated he feels it is important to move forward with this policy allowing for businesses to use this process as well as the cities to hopefully entice other businesses to come into our County. He also explained these incentives should not be transferrable if the business is sold or downgraded, and if they should go out of business, those incentives go away and feels that should be clearly noted in the policy as well. Commissioner Becker stated the incentive should be used for a business to grow and establish their business in our County as well as provide future taxes that are collected, and given businesses do pay a much larger tax than residential. At this time he asked the board to accept this policy and approve noting this is a living document that can be changed as needed.

Commissioner Becker made a motion to approve the Economic Development Incentive Policy For Morgan County with the amendments to the policy that the incentives should not be transferrable if the business is sold or downgraded, and if they should go out of business, those incentives would go away, as well as the policy being a live document and ever changing as to the needs of the County, with Commissioner Arndt seconding the motion. Further discussion followed with Commissioner Arndt providing his reasons for supporting the proposed incentive policy and Chairman Zwetzig providing reasons for his opposition to the proposed policy.

At this time, City of Fort Morgan, John Brennan asked to speak. He introduced Sarah Crosthwait, in the audience indicating she is the City's Economic Development Specialist, asking the question if these incentives are something that will be available to those within the City of Fort Morgan where they can be "stackable" and be able to have incentives from both the County and the City. Commissioner Becker stated he believes they should be stackable and explained the reasons why he is hoping this will be a tool for their economic development incentives.

At this time, the motion carried 2-1 with Chairman Zwetzig being the dissenting vote.

Chairman Zwetzig asked Sarah Crosthwait, Economic Development Specialist for the City of Fort Morgan to introduce herself, at which time, Ms. Crosthwait provided her background as well as details of what they have currently added to allow businesses more opportunity.

## **COUNTY OFFICIAL AND DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS**

### **Treasurer's Report**

Morgan County Treasurer and Public Trustee Robert Sagel presented to the Board the Morgan County Treasurer's 2nd Quarter Report for 2019. Mr. Sagel provided detailed information to the board and summarized the information provided. Discussion ensued regarding how the County's funds are handled and invested.

Commissioner Arndt made a motion to approve the Morgan County Treasurer's second quarter report and the Public Trustee Report for the second quarter with Commissioner Becker seconding the motion. At this time, the motion carried 3-0.

### **Centennial Mental Health Report**

Dr. Liz Hickman, Centennial Mental Health Executive Director presented to the Board an update from Centennial Mental Health. She also asked Phil Moss, the Regional Director to join her in her presentation. At this time, she provided a detailed update regarding the State's ongoing mental health issues as well as an overview of services Centennial Mental Health provides. A document reflecting statistics of current services and clients served for FY 2017-2018. She spoke about state and federal funding issues as well as informing the Board they plan to retain the 10 FTE Crisis Response Team in place, and have made staff cuts to meet the economical demands to remain as lean as possible.

Commissioner Arndt asked about the funding levels and the issue where it was believed more of the funding was going towards administration rather than treatment providers with Ms. Hickman explaining what has been placed in the current contracts and the requirements for the levels of funding that will go towards administration and explained why the northeast region's funding was cut so drastically given it was based on population and poverty levels and not based on the 17,647 square miles the region covers.

Chairman Zwetzig asked if there is an increase in the need for substance abuse services with Ms. Hickman stating she does not believe there has been an increase but does not see it decreasing either. Discussion followed regarding the continuum of care with Ms. Hickman stating those individuals that come through the criminal justice system, those services seem to be much broader.

The structure of the Centennial Mental Health board was discussed with Chairman Zwetzig noting Jacque Frenier is the board's appointee to serve on the board and Sheriff Dave Martin who represents the community member on the board to represent Morgan County.

Ms. Hickman provided information regarding a scholarship program they offer for individuals who are headed toward a degree that is behavioral health related hoping to recruit local citizens to apply.

At this time, Mr. Moss spoke about those services being provided at the local level in Morgan County providing detailed information. Mr. Moss stated their relationship with those agencies in Morgan County who refer to them has been excellent and commended Ms. Frenier for her collaboration. He further spoke about his recent opportunity

to have participated in some leadership training stating it was a great experience for him and provided detailed highlights surrounding discussions they had surrounding equity and diversity. He also spoke about the community garden they have located in the back of the Fort Morgan office building expressing his excitement about getting the garden in place.

Commissioners reviewed the calendar dated July 19, 2019 through July 30, 2019 with possible changes.

Commissioner Arndt provided the road and bridge department explaining they are doing normal maintenance and repairs on County Road 8.

Being no further business the meeting was then adjourned at 10:13 a.m.
