Optional Write-in



To vote for a qualified write-in candidate, write the person's name in the blank space provided and FILL IN THE OVAL to the left.

WARNING: Any person who, by use of force or other means, unduly influences an eligible elector to vote in any particular manner or to refrain from voting, or who falsely makes, alters, forges or counterfeits any mail ballot before or after it has been cast, or who destroys, defaces, mutilates, or tampers with a ballot is subject, upon conviction, to imprisonment, or to a fine, or both. <p>Ballot questions referred by the general assembly or any political subdivision are listed by letter, and ballot questions initiated by the people are listed numerically. A ballot question listed as an "amendment" proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and a ballot question listed as a "proposition" proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. Morgan County Park and Recreation District Ballot Issue 6B

SHALL MORGAN COUNTY PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT DEBT BE INCREASED \$31.5 MILLION WITH A REPAYMENT COST OF \$61 MILLION TO ACQUIRE, BUILD, RENOVATE AND EQUIP RECREATION AMENITIES WITHIN MORGAN COUNTY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

1. BUILDING RECREATIONAL FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO A RECREATION AND AQUATIC CENTER WHICH MAY INCLUDE A LEISURE POOL, LAP POOL, CHANGING ROOMS, AND COMMUNITY ROOMS,
2. BUILDING RECREATIONAL FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF BRUSH (WHICH MAY INCLUDE CONSTRUCTING A FIELDHOUSE AND/OR REPAIRING AND IMPROVING, OR REPLACING THE EXISTING AQUATICS FACILITIES) AND
3. BUILDING RECREATIONAL FACILITIES IN THE TOWN OF WIGGINS (WHICH MAY INCLUDE A FIELDHOUSE AND/OR AQUATICS FACILITIES);

SUCH DEBT TO BE PAID FROM ANY LEGALLY AVAILABLE DISTRICT REVENUES, AND BE ISSUED AND SOLD ON TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS PERMITTED BY LAW, INCLUDING PROVISIONS FOR REDEMPTION PRIOR TO MATURITY WITH OR WITHOUT PAYMENT OF A MAXIMUM PREMIUM OF 3%; AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH DEBT AND ANY RELATED INVESTMENT INCOME BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LIMITS PROVIDED BY LAW?
