

NOTICE TO ELECTORS IN MORGAN COUNTY

Morgan County Clerk and Recorder Susan Bailey would like to provide the registered electors in Morgan County an update on the TABOR notices for the upcoming election on November 5, 2019.

The notices were prepared and mailed by the deadline set by TABOR. Unfortunately, through no fault of Morgan County or the Morgan County Clerk, the notices have not been received by the local post offices here in Morgan County for forwarding on to the registered electors. Since determining that the notices had not been received, the Morgan County Clerk has been in regular contact with both the Colorado Secretary of State and Election Coordinator with the United States Postal Service, who is investigating the incident.

The County wants to ensure that registered electors receive the required TABOR notices and cannot wait until the outcome of the USPS' investigation. As a result, the Clerk has undertaken to print and mail substitute notices to registered electors. It is Clerk's goal that substitute notices will be mailed out from the local post offices no later than Thursday, October 17th.

If, for some reason, voters receive multiple notices, please be assured that the text of the notices is identical.
