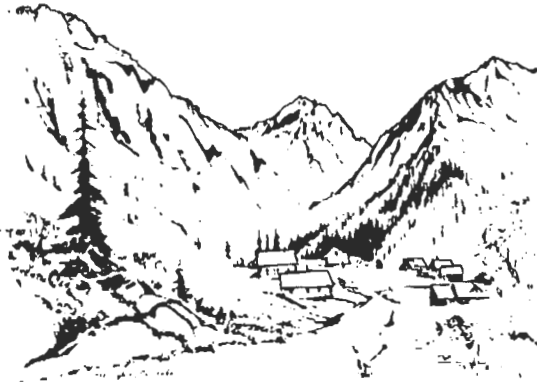

## Resolution 2000-1


### Supporting Preservation of the Telluride Valley Floor as Open Space


Whereas, the General Assembly finds that the preservation of open space and natural viewsapes is essential to the preservation of the unique life style and environment of this region; and,
