TOWN OF OPHIR

FINDING THAT THE FERRIC OXIDE PLACER IS ELIGIBLE ~~FOR~~
ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, the Town of Ophir owns the Ferric Oxide Placer, has filed a petition for annexation, and the General Assembly of the Town of Ophir has adopted **Resolution No. 2008-1 Initiating Annexation of the Ferric Oxide Placer, Finding the Petition for Annexation to be in Substantial Compliance, and Setting a Public Hearing;** and

WHEREAS, the Town of Ophir held a public hearing on July 1, 2008, after providing required notice in accordance with C.R.S. §31-12-108; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Ophir desires to set forth its findings regarding the Petition for Annexation of the Ferric Oxide Placer in accordance with C.R.S. §31-12-110;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE TOWN OF OPHIR, the following:

SECTION 1. Eligibility. The General Assembly finds that the requirements of C.R.S. §31-12-104 and §31-12-105 have been met. Specifically, the General Assembly finds that the perimeter Ferric Oxide Placer is one sixth contiguous with the Town of Ophir and that a community of interest exists.

SECTION 2. No Election Required. The General Assembly finds that the no election is required because the Town of Ophir is the owner of 100% of the property petitioning for annexation.

SECTION 3. No Additional Terms or Conditions. The General Assembly finds that no additional terms or conditions are to be imposed on the annexation of the Ferric Oxide Placer.
