



# Committee Member Profile

## *Jane Bral, P.G.*

Ms. Bral graduated from Ohio University in Athens, Ohio, in 1980 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Geology and in 1984 with a Master of Science degree in Hydrogeology. She worked with Environmental Science and Engineering (ESE) for 13 years in Gainesville, Florida, and Denver, Colorado, doing petroleum and hazardous waste site assessment and remediation. In 1998, she founded Bral Environmental, Inc., that specializes in Phase I and II site assessments. In 1999, she joined the Colorado Department of Labor and Employment - Division of Oil and Public Safety as an Environmental Protection Specialist in the Remediation Section, where she oversaw the assessment and remediation of petroleum-contaminated sites. In 2004, she began managing the Colorado Petroleum Storage Tank Fund, which provides annual reimbursements of \$35M to \$40M. In 2017 she returned to the OPS Remediation Section and now in addition to overseeing site assessments and cleanups she manages the Petroleum Cleanup and Redevelopment Fund which provides reimbursement for tank removals and assessment and cleanup of “Brownfields” sites that are not eligible to the Petroleum Storage Tank Fund.
