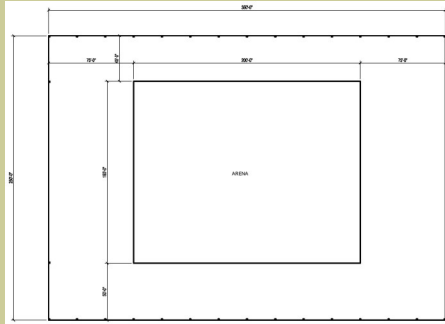
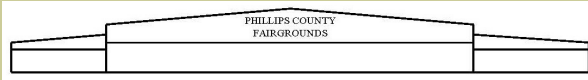

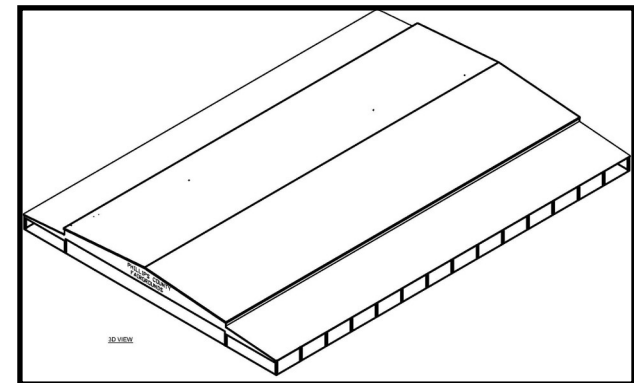

**A Wise Way for Farmers to give**

*Example of how you could save:*

The Challenge

Your gift could be wheat, corn, beans, millet, beets—the commodity you grow. Our challenge would be to encourage giving 1,000 bushels or maybe more. Your gift could also be to pledge a number of bushels per year up to 5 years.

Cash Method of Accounting	
1,000 BU corn @ \$3.50	
ASSUMING 28% TAX BRACKET	
NET SELF-EMPLOYMENT TAX SAVINGS:	
(\$3500 x 0.9235 x 0.153)	\$494.53
DEDUCTION FOR HALF OF SELF-EMPLOYMENT TAX	
	\$247.27
FEDERAL INCOME TAX SAVINGS (\$3500-\$247.27x.28)	
	\$910.76
STATE INCOME TAX SAVINGS (\$3500 - \$247.27) x .05)	
	<u>\$162.64</u>
<b>INITIAL TAX SAVINGS</b>	<b><u>\$1,567.93</u></b>
PLUS	
Enterprise Zone In Kind Credit (12.5%)	<u>\$437.50</u>
<b>Total Tax Savings</b>	<b>\$2,005.43</b>

**What is the 1,000 Bushel Club?**

The Fairgrounds Fundraising Committee is challenging agricultural producers to donate grain to the new Phillips County Fairgrounds Pavilion & Education Center through the **1,000 Bushel Club**. Our economy is almost entirely based on agriculture, a base that sustains us day in and day out.

The **1,000 Bushel Club** donors will receive recognition for their agricultural productivity and their community-minded spirit. A gift of grain is not only a great investment in Phillips County, but also a prudent way to donate, reducing federal and state income taxes by lowering overall income and reducing self-employment tax.

Donated bushels are not counted as income.

1,000 Bushels    \$3,500.00 Example of corn  
 - \$1,567.93 Initial tax savings  
 - \$ 437.50 Enterprise Zone Credit  
 \$1,494.57 Actual cost of gift

The Event Center gets a donation that is 2.3 times the actual cost of your gift.
