

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO DELEGATE THE  
AUTHORITY TO THE TOWN CLERK TO APPOINT ELECTION JUDGES FOR ALL  
TOWN OF PITKIN ELECTIONS

RESOLUTION NO. 2  
SERIES 2018

WHEREAS, the Town of Pitkin conducts Regular Elections on the first Tuesday in the month of April in even-numbered years and such elections require the appointment of Election Judges; and

WHEREAS, from time to time, the Town of Pitkin may conduct special elections and such elections require the appointment of Election Judges; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Municipal Election Code specifies how such appointments are to be made in CRS 31-10-401; and

WHEREAS, the timing and process of making appointments may be cumbersome in the context of the timing of the regular Board of Trustee meetings; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees desires to delegate this authority to the Clerk in the interest of efficiency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, that;

1. The Town Clerk is hereby delegated authority to appoint Election Judges for all elections in the Town of Pitkin.
2. The minimum number of judges will be sufficient to meeting statutory requirements and also to fulfill the needs of this specific election.
3. The Town Clerk is also authorized to determine appropriate compensation for the Election Judges based on statutory requirements and best practices among municipalities;
