

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO, UTILIZING THE
UNIFORM ELECTION CODE OF 1992 IN LIEU OF THE MUNICIPAL
ELECTION CODE OF 1965 IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN A COORDINATED
ELECTION WITH GUNNISON COUNTY ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018.**

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes Section 31-10-102(7) Municipal Election Code, permits that any municipality may provide by ordinance or resolution that will utilize the requirements and procedures of the “Uniform Election Code of 1992”, Articles 1 to 13 of Title 1, C.R.S. in lieu of C.R.S. 31-10, with respect to any election; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pitkin, Colorado intends to coordinate a special election on November 6, 2018 with the Gunnison County Clerk and Recorder,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, as follows:

1. The Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, hereby incorporates the foregoing recitals as findings;
2. The Town of Pitkin, Colorado hereby adopts the Uniform Election Code of 1992 in lieu of the Colorado Municipal Code of 1965 for the purpose of participating in a coordinated election on Tuesday, November 6, 2018 in accordance with the provisions of Section 31-10-102(7), C.R.S.;
3. The Clerk of the Town of Pitkin is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary and appropriate actions to effectuate the provisions of this resolution in accordance with Colorado law.
4. Pursuant to C.R.S. 31-10-102(7), the Town will utilize the requirements and procedures of the Uniform Election Code of 1992 in lieu of the Colorado Municipal Election of 1965, as amended, with respect to the special municipal election held on November 6, 2018, and such election shall be conducted as part of the coordinated election with Gunnison County.
