 - D. The building has architectural significance.

- (1) 1882 house of Doug Bower at 408 State Street. (B)
- (2) Stable at 629 Main Street owned by Ed Herman. (B and C)
- (3) 1881 Brooks House, State Street owned by John Brooks (B)
- (4) Assay office on Main St. (B,C. D)
