

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 FOR THE TOWN OF PITKIN, STATE OF COLORADO (Pursuant to §29-1-604, C.R.S.)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin wishes to claim exemption from the audit requirements of §29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, §29-1-604 (2)(b), C.R.S. states that any local government where either revenue or expenditures are \$100,000.00 but not more than \$750,000.00 may, with the approval of the State Auditor, be exempt from the provisions of §29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, expenditures exceeded \$100,000.00 but were not more than \$750,000.00 for the Town of Pitkin for Fiscal Year 2018 and income did not exceed \$100,000.00; and

WHEREAS an application for exemption from audit for the Town of Pitkin has been prepared by Holscher, Mayberry & Company, LLC, an independent accountant with knowledge of governmental accounting, and


WHEREAS, said application for exemption from audit has been completed in accordance with regulations, issued by the State Auditor.




