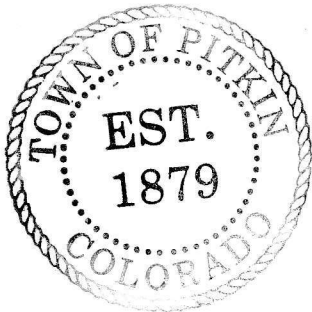
WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes (2009), 31-15-101, et seq., authorizes a municipality to enact regulations that promote the health, safety and welfare, and improve order, comfort, and convenience of the municipality and inhabitants thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Conduct for Elected Officials, attached hereto, and incorporated as though set forth fully herein, provides guidelines designed to improve communications between the Board of Trustees and the Mayor, and otherwise serves to increase the public's confidence in the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin has determined that the Town of Pitkin, Colorado would benefit from the adoption of the Code of Conduct for Elected Officials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Pitkin Code of Conduct for Elected Officials shall be adopted by the Town of Pitkin Board of Trustees.
