RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE BUILDINGS WITH HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

RESOLUTION NO. 7, SERIES 2017

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Pitkin, Colorado, is a significant part of the history of Colorado, and

**WHEREAS**, local recognition as an historical building or property is required for buildings or properties seeking State of Colorado recognition as a historical property, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Pitkin wishes to recognize specific buildings and properties as having historical significance,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PITKIN, COLORADO:**

That the Town of Pitkin and the Pitkin Historical and Community Association seek to recognize buildings and properties of historical value, and

That owners will voluntarily present buildings or properties to the Pitkin Historical and Community Association Board for consideration of becoming a listed historical building, and

That the Pitkin Historical and Community Association Board will use due diligence in authenticating the age, construction, historical significance in Pitkin, and other significant factors of the building or property, and

Buildings and properties meeting the criteria for being an historical building or property by the Pitkin Historical and Community Association will be presented to the Pitkin Board of Trustees for inclusion as a locally recognized historical building or property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:**

Buildings or properties that carry the designation as a locally recognized historical building or property are not in any way limited by this designation, and

Inclusion in any listing or map open to the public will only be done with the permission of the property owner.
