RE: Required Corrective Action Schedule Extension #2/ Wiedeman Dairy, Notice of Violation/ Cease and Desist Order Number: CO-100517-1

Dear Mr. Wiedeman:

In an October 29, 2010 letter from AGPROfessionals, LLC on behalf of the Wiedeman Dairy, the Water Quality Control Division (the "Division") received a request for an extension to the compliance dates required under paragraph 29 of the Notice of Violation/ Cease and Desist Order Number: CO-100517-1 (the "NOV/CDO"). The compliance dates required under paragraph 29 were previously extended in the Required Corrective Action Schedule Extension #1 letter ("Extension #1") from the Division to Wiedeman Dairy dated August 25, 2010. Extension #1 required Wiedeman Dairy to submit, by no later than November 30, 2010, information specifying and describing the Best Management Practices ("BMPs") the Wiedeman Dairy has implemented and will maintain to comply with the six (6) elements of 5 CCR 1002-81, §81.9 including representative photographs documenting the BMPs implemented at the Facility and the current condition of the BMPs.

Because of the Wiedeman Dairy's difficulty locating and securing a source of acceptable liner material for the impoundment and the potential for winter weather conditions delaying construction of the impoundment, the Wiedeman Dairy requested additional time to complete the requirements of Paragraph 29.

The Division hereby approves the request and formally revises Paragraph 29 of the NOV/CDO to read as follows:

If the Wiedemans choose to operate the Wiedeman Dairy (into the future) as a Medium Animal Feeding Operation as defined in 5 CCR 1002-81, §81.3 (18) (Animal Feeding Operations Control Regulations), by no later than May 30, 2011, the Wiedemans shall submit to the Division information specifying and describing the Best Management Practices ("BMPs") the Facility has implemented and will maintain to comply with the six (6) elements of 5 CCR 1002-81, §81.9. The Wiedemans shall include representative photographs documenting the BMPs implemented at the Facility and the current condition of the BMPs.

Please note that all other compliance dates referenced in or required by the NOV/CDO remain unchanged and in effect.
