WHEREAS, deceased Tribal Chairman Leonard C. Burch was a valiant leader who positively affected many lives, including citizens of the Town of Ignacio; and

WHEREAS, the Southern Ute Indian Tribe has created an annual holiday on December 10th of every year in recognition of Leonard C. Burch; and

WHEREAS, Leonard C. Burch Day is intended to signify and pay tribute to Mr. Burch's 32 years of service and numerous accomplishments; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Ignacio desires to pay respect and tribute to Leonard C. Burch; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Ignacio desires to recognize Leonard C. Burch day as an annual Town holiday.

FURTHERMORE, let it be known that the Town of Ignacio, hereby encourages its residents, businesses and institutions to celebrate **Leonard C. Burch Day** and recognize the accomplishments, sacrifices and contributions Mr. Burch made to our community.

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED, that I, Mayor Stella Cox, hereby pledge that Leonard C. Burch Day, December 10th, will be recognized annually as a Town holiday for Town staff, and will be closed for business in order for staff to be involved in the various activities, or to pay tribute in their own way.

Furnace Repair

Is your furnace in need of repair? Energy Outreach has a home furnace repair program for qualifying low-income residents.

Low-income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP) has funding available until April 30th. LEAP is a federally funded program administered by Discover Goodwill of Southern Colorado, and is designed to help low-income households with winter heating costs. 

Back Page Story Headline

This story can fit 175-225 words.

If your newsletter is folded and mailed, this story will appear on the back. So, it's a good idea to make it easy to read at a glance.

A question and answer session is a good way to quickly capture the attention of readers. You can either compile questions that you've received since the last edition or you can summarize some generic questions that are frequently asked about your organization.

A listing of names and titles of managers in your organization is a good way to give your newsletter a personal touch. If your

organization is small, you may want to list the names of all employees.

If you have any prices of standard products or services, you can include a listing of those here. You may want to refer your readers to any other forms of communication that you've created for your organization.

You can also use this space to remind readers to mark their calendars for a regular event, such as a breakfast meeting for vendors every third Tuesday of the month, or a biannual charity auction.

If space is available, this is a good

place to insert a clip art image or some other graphic.

Business Tagline or Motto

This would be a good place to insert a short paragraph about your organization. It might include the purpose of the organization, its mission, founding date, and a brief history. You could also include a brief list of the types of products, services, or programs your organization offers, the geographic area covered (for example, western U.S. or European markets), and a profile of the types of customers or members served.

It would also be useful to include a contact name for readers who want more information about the organization.
