Town of Stratton Board of Trustees emergency meeting was held on March 17, 2020 at the Stratton Activity Center. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 a.m. by Mayor, Richard Mann. **Emergency Business**

Mayor Richard Mann and Town Clerk Melanee Johnson presented the newest state wide COVID-19 and closure recommendations set forth by Governor, Polis. Our Fitness area is to be closed immediately, per state mandate. Melanee also stated that many municipalities in the state have moved to a closed to public access and/or work from home status as well as CML offices. Melanee asked that we consider closing all of our facilities to public access. It is best to be proactive versus reactive, in this situation, as we have some employees in the high risk category. A lengthy discussion ensued with pros and cons for both issues of closing/staying open. At the conclusion of the discussion, a motion was made by Arlan Tanner and seconded by Sonia Huppert for precautionary measures and recommendations from the State due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Town of Stratton will immediately close the Stratton Fitness Center, Library, and close to Public Access the Town Hall, and suspend / cancel any rentals at the Stratton Activity Center as well as the Stratton Community Building until further notice. All approved, motion passed. Notices will be posted at all doors, as well as via text alert, web page and Facebook. Notices will be put up at the Town Park reminding others of social distancing as well. Town Hall will remain staffed as usual so that phone calls and daily business will not be interrupted. Town Hall staff as well as any Library staff present today will be instructed to do deep cleaning and sanitizing both the Library and Town Hall.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Arlan Tanner made a motion, seconded by Sonia Huppert, to adjourn the meeting at 7:57 am. All approved, motion passed.
