

Phillips County Commissioner Meeting

May 27, 2016

The board met in work session prior to the regular meeting with Road & Bridge Manager Mike Salyards to discuss current work efforts.

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Commissioner Don Lock, chair, and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Also present were Commissioners Harlan Stern and Joe Kinnie, and County Administrator Randy Schafer.

Stern made a motion, seconded by Kinnie, to approve the minutes from May 19, 2016 as presented. Motion carried.

Stern made a motion, seconded by Kinnie, to approve the minute of the special meeting (public hearing on Kramer zoning amendment application) from May 19, 2016. Motion carried.

The board met with the two newspapers for the monthly press briefing.

The board met with Jerry From. He feels that the county is missing a lot of revenue by not allowing the sale of medical and recreational marijuana. They discussed the pros and cons of the marijuana business.

Stern made a motion, seconded by Kinnie to approve hiring Scott Murray as a seasonal maintenance worker for June through August/September (as the work load warrants) at an hourly rate of \$10. Motion carried.

Stern made a motion, seconded by Kinnie, to approve the fair board entering into a contract with Dustin Evans and Good Times for entertainment at the 2016 Phillips County Fair. Motion carried. The contract was reviewed by the County Attorney.

The board approved May payroll and a May accounts payable batch.

The board reviewed the upcoming schedule of events for Rural Philanthropy Days.

The board reviewed Human Service Director applications and plan to conduct interviews on June 13th.

The board unanimously opposes the ballot issue Amendment 69 regarding a universal health system for Colorado. They signed a letter to CCI asking them to oppose the initiative.

The board agreed that the large projector screens and projectors are available to all renters at the Event Center.




