BALLOT TITLE: AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES XVII, XX, AND XXIV OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO, CONCERNING THE ELIMINATION OF OBSOLETE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION.

Summary of Referendum

This referendum amends the state constitution to eliminate the following obsolete provisions:

- the requirement that conscientious objectors pay for their exemption from militia duty;
- references to outdated requirements for the consolidation of several City and County of Denver school districts into a single school district; and
- references to dates and outdated statutory provisions regarding the Old Age Pension Fund.

Repealing or amending obsolete provisions will not affect state or local revenues or spending and, therefore, the referendum is assessed as having no fiscal impact. It takes effect upon approval of the voters at the November 2006 general election.
