HB 06S-1014 Illegal Immigration Costs Reimbursement	HB 06S-1022 Attorney General Initiate Immigration Lawsuit

During the special session, the legislature adopted two bills directing the state Attorney General to take specific actions to address the problem of illegal immigration.

HB 06S-1014 requires the Colorado Attorney General to pursue all available remedies to recover from the federal government the costs incurred by the state in dealing with illegal immigration.

HB 06S-1022 directs the Colorado Attorney General to initiate or join other states in a lawsuit against the U.S. Attorney General to demand the enforcement of all existing federal immigration laws. The enactment of the bill is contingent upon voter approval at the November 2006 general election.
