Greetings Neighbors,

Water Quality: The Board continues to monitor water quality so if you feel your quality is not what it should be, let us know by calling **303-987-0835**.

New Technology: The Board recently had the opportunity to see a demonstration of a new technology developed by the Denver-based corporation Altela. The system is called the AtelaRain® Module Treatment System. It is a distillation system. This system has the capability of taking the waste stream water generated by our Reverse Osmosis and returning a significant portion of it back to us for our use instead of sending it to our evaporation ponds. As an example, last month we sent 225,000 gallons of brine from our RO plant to the evaporation ponds. With this technology we could potentially reduce that number to just a few thousand gallons, thereby solving the problem we have had with not having enough capacity in our evaporation ponds. Right now, the water that is reclaimed is not State approved for us to feed back into our drinking water but it is an asset that has the potential to return revenue to the District.

The Board has initiated a letter of intent with Altela for the purpose of developing an accurate estimate of the Capital and Operating costs associated with the procurement of this system. I'll provide you with updates as they occur.

Fire Hydrants: I want to remind everyone that the fire hydrants in your neighborhood belong to the District and to use the fire hydrants to obtain water without the express consent of the district is a Class 2 misdemeanor to tamper with hydrant and a Class 2 misdemeanor for theft of the water as well as a violation of the District's rules and regulations, which carries a fine of \$2,000. The District does have a procedure in place for an entity to access a fire hydrant for the purposes of obtaining water. If you need water from a hydrant, please contact our management office at 303-987-0835.
