Denver Central Driver License Office to relocate March 27

January 12, 2017 - Denver, Colo. - The Denver Central Driver License Office, currently located at 1865 W. Mississippi Ave., in Denver, will relocate to 3265 S. Wadsworth Blvd. on March 27, 2017.

The lease at the current location expired and the new location was chosen through a bid process, to which the current landlord did not respond.

The new location, located 6.6 miles from the previous location, offers more space, which will allow the DMV to maintain the current level of service, while allowing for future options of expanding service capability. The new location is also easier to access as it is located on bus lines 30, 78 and 87L and offers convenient, free parking for customers arriving by car.

“This move is part of the Colorado Department of Revenue’s Division of Motor Vehicles’ continuing goals to improve customer service and reduce wait times by opening a larger location that is convenient for, and easily accessible by, Colorado residents,” said Driver License Operations Director David Lindsay. “This location gives us an opportunity to expand services in the future, which will allow us to continue to serve our state’s growing population in an efficient manner.”

The following services will be offered at the new location:

- Issuance of new driver licenses, instruction permits and identification cards.
- Renewal of driver licenses, instruction permits and identification cards.
- Motor vehicle (driving) records.
- Written tests for non-commercial and commercial driver licenses (CDL) and motorcycle endorsements.
- Drive skills test for non-commercial driver licenses and motorcycle endorsements (appointment only).
- Reinstatements.
- SB13-251 appointments.
- Remote Exceptions Processing.
