Water Quality: The Board continues to monitor water quality so if you feel your quality is not what it should be, let us know by calling **303-987-0835**.

With the end of irrigation season we are seeing a significant reduction in the amount of Total Dissolved Solids (TDS) and hardness of the water that we are producing. This is a normal cycle for us and these levels should remain low through the winter season.

Project update: As reported in previous newsletters, the Board has been pursuing the acquisition of new technology that will improve our water quality and recover some of the water that we currently send to our evaporation ponds. We have also planned on building a new water treatment facility at our site in Box Elder Creek Ranch. Well, these plans have been put on hold. The Board has been notified by the CEO of Altela, Inc. that until they resolve a license dispute on their patented technology they will be unable to sell their system to us. This could take upwards of a couple of years to resolve. Until then, we will continue our search for a solution to our problem.
